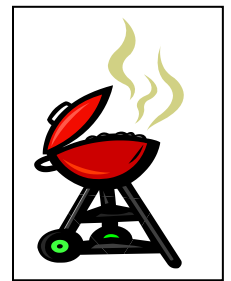

The Community Center of Hope is proud to host the ninth annual **“Smoke on the Square” BBQ Competition**. This family event will be held on **May 17th and 18th, 2019** on the Hope Town Square.

This is an opportunity for you, as a BBQ Competitor, to become an active partner to assist the Community Center of Hope with the numerous programs and services offered to the community. This includes our Education Programs that fill the needs of children ranging from 6 weeks to 6th grade. We offer a state licensed Infant/Toddler Program, Preschool, Before/After School, and Summer Camp. The Community Center also is the home to the Hope Food Pantry.

Smoke on the Square is open to all levels of competitors. The winners are determined by a panel of judges that consist of several Kansas City Barbeque Society certified judges and other trained judges. There will be one table captain per judging table. These judges will determine the winners in each category of **brisket, pork ribs, pulled pork, chicken, dessert and sauce**. The first 20 competitors will be eligible to enter a separate People’s Choice Competition with the winner determined by public vote.

The 2018 competition brought hundreds of people to the Hope Town Square to enjoy this family focused event. We received all positive feedback from competitors and attendees. We hope the 2019 event will be just as successful as the past events.

Smoke on the Square Cornhole Rules

Saturday, May 18, 2019

Hope Town Square

- **Tournament starts Saturday May 18th at 11:00am. Registration fee is \$50 per team.**
- **Boards are placed 27ft from front edge to front edge.**
- **Games are played to 21 points.**
- **Woody: Refers to any cornhole bag that has been pitched and remains on the cornhole board playing surface at the conclusion of the frame. Each woody is 1pt.**
- **Cornhole – Refers to any cornhole bag that has been pitched and passes through the cornhole board hole at any time within the frame. Each cornhole is 3pts.**
- **A bag that comes to rest touching the ground AND the board does not count as a point.**
- **Cancellation Scoring: The approved method of scoring for the sport of cornhole is “cancellation” scoring. In cancellation scoring, the points of one player cancel out the points of their opponent. Using this method, only one player/team can score in each frame.**
- **Both players play one board at a time and stay in their designated lane for the whole game (right or left).**
- **Players start the game at board 1 and alternate pitching bags until each player has pitched all (4) of his/her bags.**
- **Players then walk to the end of their lane to the other board, take score, and resume pitching back to the other cornhole board.**
- **Players must deliver the bag with an underhand release.**
- **Feet must stay behind the line of the front of the board at the time of releasing the bag.**
- **The player/team who scored in the preceding frame pitches first in the next frame. If neither player/team scores, the player/team who pitched first in the preceding frame shall retain first pitch in the next frame.**
- **If bags become piled inside the cornhole board hole and may interfere or obstruct with the next pitch or if there is question whether a cornhole bag would have naturally fallen through the hole, a player may request to “rake” the cornhole bags that have fallen inside the hole.**

Rules are followed from the American Cornhole Organization.
